ADVOCACY

ADVOCACY IS ESSENTIAL FOR WORLD VISION.

WHAT IS ADVOCACY?

- Advocacy is **challenging and proposing changes** to current policy implications that make it difficult for vulnerable children and their families to escape poverty and other inequalities.
- Advocacy involves fathering first-hand experiences of **people working within communities** in the developing world.
- Advocacy work is done through **local, national, regional, and global platforms**.



HOW HAS ADVOCACY MADE AN IMPACT ON THE GLOBAL COMMUNITY?

- World Vision has partnered with leading **international humanitarian organizations** to bring action to the government surrounding issues of gender equality, development, equal access to education, access to food, and safety over the years.
- World Vision has participated in public displays (ie. stunts and performances) to grab the **media's attention** into resolving these issues through creative demonstration and representations.
- World Vision has **gained attention of political leaders of the G7** to deliver and fulfill these promises made to children in previous summit meetings.
- World Vision will continue to work alongside you and partner organizations for more systemic changes. You are in charge of the change.



HOW CAN YOU GET INVOLVED?

1. **SPEAK UP.** Tell the Government of Canada that you want to prioritize **greater transparency** within global supply chains to end child labor.
2. **TAKE ACTION.** **Sign the petition** "No Child For Sale (NCFS)" today so that each child has the chance to be a kid. Demand greater **corporate transparency** and let kids be kids.
3. **GET INVOLVED.** **Spread awareness** about the importance of global supply chains in the production of our clothing.

It is time to disconnect ourselves from child labor today. Sign the petition for change and join us by calling on our government to introduce the Supply Chain Transparency Legislation in Canada **today**.
